1. What role does praise play in Australian culture? Do Aussies use praise well or poorly?
2. What do you think is the main concern of Psalm 133 (pay special attention to verse 1)? What do you think is the main concern of Psalm 134 (the key verse appears to be verse 2)?
3. Psalm 133: How is unity among God's people like precious oil poured over the high priest and the dew of Mt Hermon on Mt Zion (Jerusalem)?
4. Psalm 134: Why do you think the song-writer calls "the servants of the LORD" to praise the LORD "in the house of the LORD"? [Hint: the 'songs of ascent' are for the pilgrimage to the temple in Jerusalem]
5. Psalm 133: What attitudes are necessary for there to be unity among God's people? What actions can we take in our church and life group to foster unity?  
Psalm 134: What are different ways that we can praise the LORD in our daily lives? What are some of the benefits of praising the LORD?
